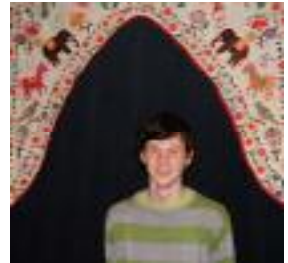

Joe Wins National Arts Young Achiever Award

After successfully completing his Silver Arts Award at Mythstories last summer Dez was moved to nominate Joe White as a Young Arts Achiever. "Joe did some fantastic work in gaining the first silver award in storytelling, culminating in a polished performance of four new stories on a storywalk. He's also led the STWYtellers group as chairperson, it seemed time for recognition."



And recognised they were, Joe won the Young Achiever of the Year 2009 award in the 16-19 Art category in November. Joe will receive a cheque for £1000, as a cash prize to spend as he sees fit; fellowship of the Royal Society of the Arts; a 'money-can't-buy' prize; and lots of free advice from 'UnLtd' and the Young Achievers Trust.
