Mythstories museum in Shropshire has been working with Storytelling for over thirteen years, and has been running training programs in storytelling for most of that time. We now offer the following five workshops as well as bespoke programmes to suit your training needs.

1. Speaking out

This is a one day experience which gives staff the confidence to speak and the skills to listen analytically. It is offered at Mythstories Museum in Wem – a purpose-built, interactive environment. It is an active workshop, working with traditional tales and participative games.

2. Interpretation and perception

This one-day interactive workshop looks at reshaping words and ideas. Using oral narrative, it examines not only what you mean by your words, but what others take from them. Participants will explore ways of representing ideas for more effective impact, play with perspective and hone in to find a focus.

Ideal for changing organizations and staff dipping their toes into uncharted waters.

3. An object orientated approach

This workshop introduces participants to objects that tell stories, and explores which stories suit which objects. It is offered at Mythstories Museum in Wem so participants can use the artefacts on display. Discover how you can use or make objects that can inspire young and old alike.

4. What you are looking at, a new perspective

This one-day workshop introduces participants to how stories can help people see their landscape in a different way. It includes opportunities for participants to try out some basic storytelling techniques and share some of the skills of staging a successful storywalk. It is offered on site so participants can use the landscape in which they are expected to work.

5. Words in the woods

A half day workshop for KS1 or KS2 Forest School Leaders and Literacy Coordinators, designed to demonstrate how you can make full use of these beautiful settings to deliver literacy targets. These highly interactive workshops explore the structure of story and how you can lay it out on the woodland floor. Delivered using your own outdoor space.
